



Viva Aerobus reports preliminary monthly passenger figures corresponding to May 2020

Mexico City, June 5, 2020. - Viva Aerobus, Mexico's ultra-low-cost carrier, reports its preliminary monthly passenger figures corresponding to May 2020. The airline registered just over 117 thousand passengers this month, a decrease of 88.2% compared to May 2019 caused by the health emergency following the COVID-19 outbreak. The load factor was 83.4%, 7.7 percentage points less than the same month last year.

The capacity of Viva Aerobus, measured in available seat kilometers, decreased by 85.7% compared to May 2019, as a result of strategic management of its route offer according to current demand. In this sense, the airline operated around 40 routes in May and announced 52 routes available for June.

Regarding the accumulated total for the year (January-May 2020), Viva Aerobus reported more than 3 million passengers and an average load factor of 84.4%. These results, compared to the accumulated January - May 2019, implied a decrease of 28.9% in terms of passengers and a decrease of 5.1 percentage points in the load factor.

Glossary

- **ASK** (Available Seat Kilometers): Seat available for sale that flies 1 kilometer (regardless of whether it is occupied or not).
- **RPK** (Revenue Passenger Kilometers): Indicates the total distance flown by passengers who paid for their transport in kilometers. It is the measure of the total traffic of passengers who paid for flying (excludes courtesies, employees, etc.).
- **Load Factor**: Represents the percentage of reserved seats in an aircraft or fleet in a certain period.
